VICTORY AND FAITH COME BY HEARING —

Victory and faith come by hearing the Word of God. The Bible says in Romans 10:17, "So faith comes from hearing, that is, hearing the Good News about Christ."

If we listen to negative reports and surround ourselves with negative people, our faith will be threatened, and our hearts will be filled with the opposite of faith—fear. When we allow fear to come in, there will be torment, anxiety, and oppression in our lives. This is not our portion or our inheritance as children of God. Let's not give our ear gate, eye gate, or mouth gate over to the voice of fear. Let's be like Joshua and meditate on the Word of God day and night. We must fill and charge our hearts with the spirit of victory and the spirit of faith.


Joshua 1:8 says, "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success."

When we spend time in the Word, we will receive a rhema word. A rhema word is a specific word from the Holy Spirit directly to us. The Holy Spirit reveals the word to us, then that word moves from head knowledge to revelation knowledge. Today, allow the Holy Spirit to reveal to you that victory is not just for everyone else, but victory is for you, your children, your spouse, finances, health, and every area of your life.

If the enemy has attacked you and you feel defeated, don't back down; you have the victory! The Bible says we have to take the Word of God, which is the sword of the Spirit, and combat the lies of the enemy (Hebrews 4:12). This is how Jesus defeated Satan, and where you and the enemy will begin to battle. We must put our faith in the Word of God, then from that place, any time we are in a battle, our response will be "it is written!"

Matthew 4:4 But Jesus said, "It is written, 'Man is not to live on bread only. Man is to live by every word that God speaks."

MOUNTAIN MOVING FAITH



Sometimes, when we receive a word, a battle arises. The Bible warns in Mark 4:15 that Satan comes immediately to steal the word. Hell gets nervous because the enemy knows that if we have that word in our hearts and we begin to speak and release it, there is no power in hell that can stop the Word of God. Once it's released, and we start calling things that are not as though they are, we're tapping into God's supernatural, mountain moving power that defeats diseases, conquers illnesses, and overcomes addiction and poverty.

The victory is in our hearts and mouths. What is in your heart today? What are you confessing? As Matthew 12:34 says, "Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks." We must confess the Word in the midst of our battle. We must get the Word in our hearts and declare it with our mouths; this is how we release the power of the Word of God. When we operate like this, in the spiritual realm, we will become a sword for the Lord, breaking things open.

VICTORY IN EVERY BATTLE

THE KEY TO VICTORY: THE WORD OF GOD

When we are in a big faith fight, the key is to watch sermons and saturate ourselves in the Word every moment we can. We don't need people's opinions, unbelief, or fear. In a faith fight, we only need the Word of God. We can't allow just anyone to speak into our lives in the midst of a faith fight. The devil will do anything to rob the word God has imparted into us. We cannot let what it looks like rob the promise of God from our hearts. We walk by faith and not by sight.

When God gives us a word of faith, destiny, or encouragement, we must protect that word and guard it-that word is going to produce a harvest. When we're about to step into something great, the enemy turns up the heat—the persecution, the trial, and the distraction. But we have to be locked in.

James 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

We need to have tenacity. We're not giving up our victory. We will stand on the word of God and declare it. The promises in the Word are from God, and God is not like man; He doesn't lie (Numbers 23:19). Today, praise God like whatever you are believing for is already done and thank God in advance for the victory. When Abraham received the word of God, he did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief. Instead, Abraham was strengthened in faith, giving praise and glory to God (Romans 4:20-25).

Don't let the enemy rob your victory. This is the victory that overcame the world, even our faith (1 John 5:4). Praise the Lord who has given victory to His people, just as He promised. Not one word has failed of all the promises He gave to His servant Moses. Every word God promised you will come to pass. As you wait for your breakthrough: praise God, meditate on His Word, and don't wait with your head down. Wait strong in the Lord and in faith. Make up your mind as you wait; don't let the enemy intimidate you. We carry the Victory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As we face trials, stand strong and refuse to let go of the victory God declared over our life. Guard the promises in your heart, and in tough times, praise God as if victory has already happened. His promises are true, and our breakthrough is coming. In Him, we stand strong, carrying the victory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
