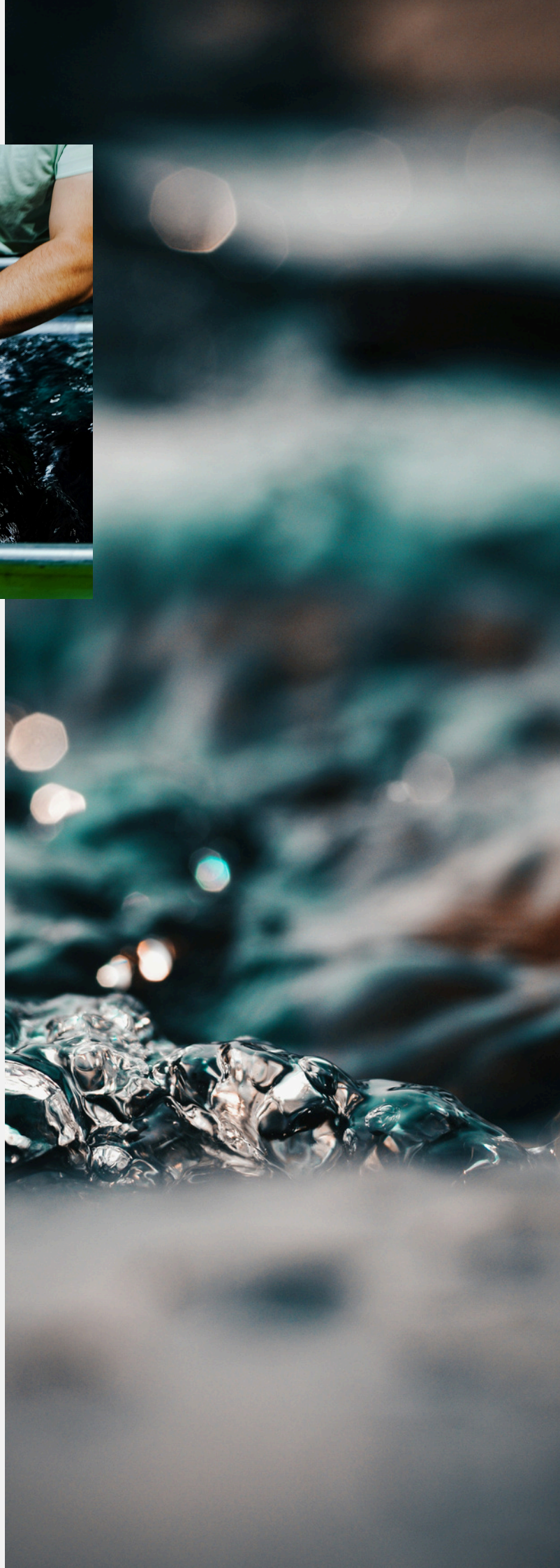
MADE NEW

2 Corinthians 5:17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

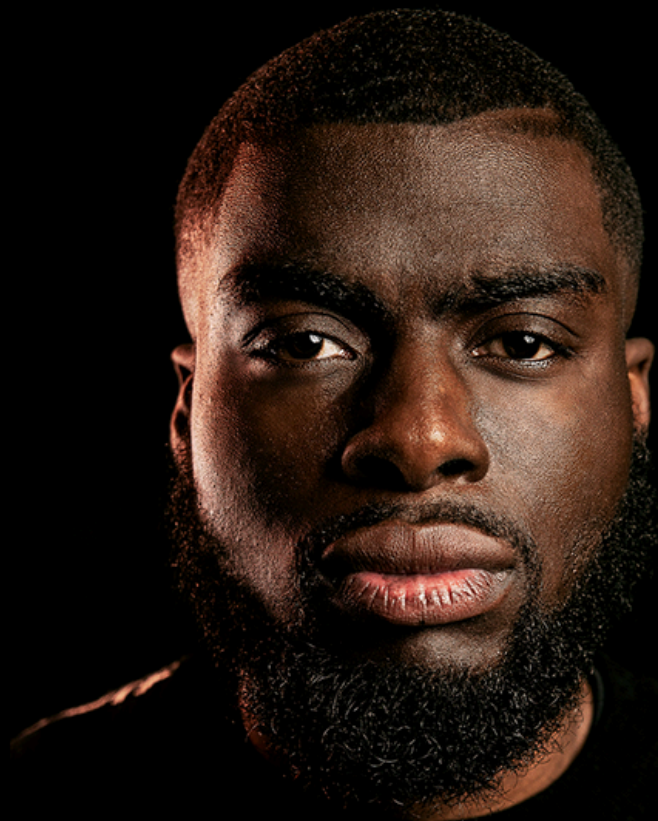

The old you is Gone.

Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

It often throws off our families, friends, and the world when we start proclaiming, 'We're Christians now,' 'We're born again,' 'We're saved.' And what do they hit back with? 'Sure, but you're still struggling financially,' or 'You say you're saved, but what about those not-so-great habits?' or 'Saved, but it's just a phase'

We can be transformed by the renewing of our mind. The only way to do this is to be in the word and pray, daily! Have you ever noticed how much better you are when you pray and read the word? How much easier it is to walk in the spirit and not the flesh? It's because we are connected to the One who makes us new! We are connected to the One who helps us renew our mind!



GOD'S IMAGE OF YOU

Self-image is the belief we have about ourselves because of what we look like and what people have said about us. It's the picture we have painted of ourselves based off of our outward situations, circumstances, or voices.

Our spirit knows how God sees us, but trouble with our self image comes from our body and soul—the mind, will, and emotions. That's where the real fight takes place. A poor self-image messes with us. Even though God's shouting our identity from the rooftops, our mind, will, emotions, and body put up a fight. It's like this internal wrestling match: God says one thing, but our whole being seems to be speaking the opposite. This mostly comes from allowing the world to influence our self image.

Ephesians 2:1 (msg) You let the world, which doesn't know the first thing about living, tell you how to live.

Don't let the world tell you who you are. You are not your past. You are not your mistakes. You are who God says you are. Christianity isn't a list of do's and don'ts. It's about embracing who you already are and becoming who God says you can be.

The power of words

Words shape our self-image and our beliefs. Negative words create a negative self-image, but God's words transform us. We need to declare what God says about us, not just publicly, but privately too. That's how we build a new self-image, a new identity.

God sees us, His people, His children, and He wants to set us free from every form of bondage. Deliverance is the first step, then we have to let go of our old, victim, poverty mindset. God wanted to take the Israelites into the Promised Land, but they had to believe it first. Their doubt and fear held them back. God couldn't force them in. Today, let's make a commitment to God that we will embrace the truth of who we are in Him, be willing to believe, and step up to do all He has called us to do!
